Billy, don't cry.



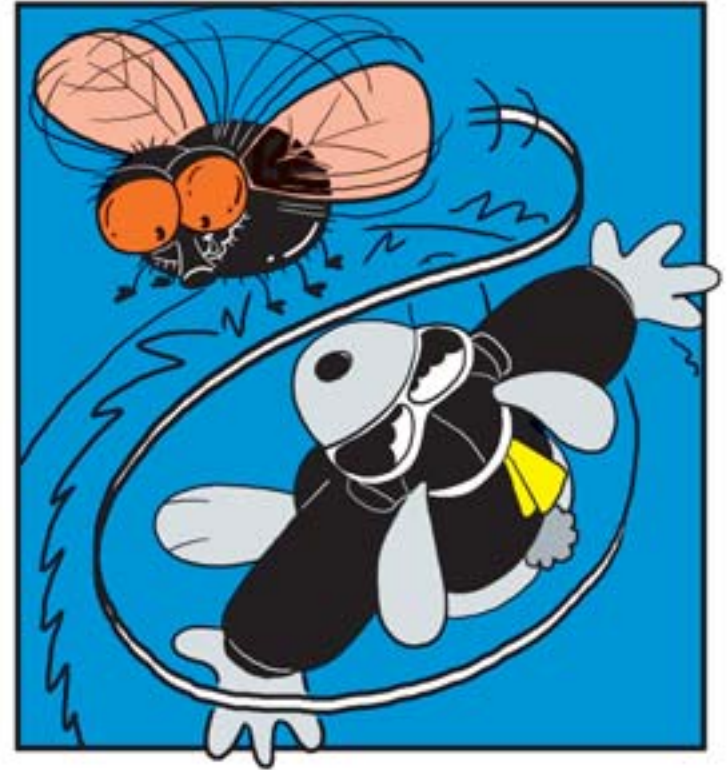
Dotty Duck can fly by.
